SANCTION This meet will be held under USA Swimming Sanction # *KYSC1202* issued by Kentucky Swimming Inc.

SITE INFORMATION An eight lane, 25 yard indoor pool with *Colorado System 5 Sports Timer, Infinity Start System, AquaGrip Touchpads,* and an eight line scoreboard. Timing for 25's will utilize the timing system with swimmers starting off the side of the pool if certified; otherwise they must start in the water at the shallow end.

Two hundred permanent seats are available inside the competition pool area for spectators and a gym floor will be covered and available for camping out by the swimmers and spectators across the hall. Ample parking is available at the front entrance to the building.

POOL MEASUREMENTS

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

WATER DEPTH: The depth of the pool at the start end is 12 feet. The depth at the turn end is 4 feet.

FACILITY NOTES 1. The two uncovered gym floors, aerobics & fitness center, track, and theater are off limits. Swimmers and spectators are not permitted into these areas.

- 2. No horseplay will be tolerated. Included are shooting baskets or tossing objects while on the covered gym floor.
- 3. Food is permitted in the food court (by the concession stand), on the covered gym floor, and in the coaches and officials hospitality room only. Beverages will be allow in the pool area but must be in a sealed, spill-proof plastic container. No glass containers are permitted inside the building.
- 4. USA Swimming and the Versailles-Woodford Co. Parks and Recreation Department prohibit smoking and alcohol.
- 5. All trash must be deposited in appropriate containers.
- 6. Signs or banners must be hung by masking tape or string only.
- 7. Radios, noisemakers, or anything else that might cause inconvenience to swimmers, coaches, officials, workers, or spectators are prohibited in the pool area. Flash photography is prohibited during the start of heats.
- 8. The operation of cell phones or walkie-talkies are prohibited inside the recreation center. Their operation interferes with the communication devices utilized by the meet officials.

| FORMAT | All events will be <u>timed-finals</u> . There are no time standards for this meet. | | | | |
| ELIGIBILITY | No swimmer who is not a USA Swimming member as provided in Article 206 or USA Swimming "open border" policy. Age is as of the first day of the meet, Oct. 1, 2011. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. | | | | |
| SWIMMERS WITH A DI | SABILITY: Entries for swimmers with a disability should be handled in the following manner: (1) enter the swimmer in the Hy-Tek database; (2) list in the email accompanying the Hy-Tek entry file (or on a separate sheet of paper) the name of the swimmer, the stroke(s)/distance(s) s/he wishes to swim, the entry times, the day/session s/he wishes to swim the event(s), and the manner in which s/he prefers to be seeded (with a longer distance or with a different age group); and (3) provide any information about special accommodations needed by the swimmer. The final determination of seeding will be made by the Meet Referee after consultation with the swimmer and his/her coach. | | | | |

| | Only electronic entries will be accepted (Hy-Tek or SDIF). Handwritten, telephoned, or faxed entries will not be accepted with the exception of the report sheet provided for utilization when entering swimmers with a disability. | ADMISSION & HEAT SHEETS | Admission for spectators ages 11 & over will be \$5.00 which will include one heat sheet. Any spectator volunteering to help us by working as a lane timer will receive their \$5.00 admission back. | | |
| CONCESSIONS | Falling Springs Arts & Recreation Center will be operating a concession stand at the site. | | |
| HOSPITALITY | There will be a hospitality room for coaches and officials immediately off of the pool deck and operating through most of the meet. | | |

Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.6 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity must be members of USA Swimming. | | |
| TIMERS | Each team will need to prepare to supply timers based upon the number of their entries. We will notify you prior to the meet via e-mail regarding your team's timer requirements. Please make the necessary preparations to supply timers before warm-ups begin so that the start of competition will not be delayed. | | |

- CLERK OF COURSE This meet will be pre-seeded with heat sheets by session given to the coaches, posted on the wall at the starting end of the pool, and for sale for \$5.00/heat sheet. Each swimmer will be required to report to the starting position at the time of the start of their event and heat. Coaches are encouraged to have an assistant available to help assure that their swimmers report promptly and to the proper lane.
- WARM-UPS
 Each team will be assigned a warm-up lane(s). Some lanes could have more than one team assigned. The coaches will control their own lanes for warm-up. Please work together if sharing lanes. Warm-up lane assignments will be e-mailed to participating teams' contact person by Tuesday, Sept. 27th and will be posted on the wall at the starting block end of the pool.
 * We reserved the right to divide the warm-up period of either session if the number of swimmers entered justifies having split session warm-ups.
 ** Everyone <u>must</u> stay off of the lane lines!
- COACHES MEETING The meet director reserve the right to conduct a coaches meeting at the close of session #1 warm-up.
- COMPETITION NOTES At present, we plan to conduct competition in lanes 2 through 8 and have lane 1 double lane lined and available for warm-up / cool-down activity through out the first session. If there is any revision to this plan for session due to entry numbers, we will notify the coaches and team contact in an email.


